Annual Report- 2016

This year the numbers of students are 1148. Last year there were 1097 students. Pass rate for class X was 100% & XII was 98.4%. Students participated in National level, state level and District level sports held at different states representing the state team in Judo Championship, Kho-Kho, Yoga Championship, Hockey championship and basket ball. Our students attended Partham Pravesh organized by Bharat Scouts & Guides in school campus. The school organized various inter house activities in sports and co-curricular activities every week as per schedule. **Picnics** were organized in two groups. Class Nursery to IX went 17 Miles and, classes X to XII went to **Maclodgunj (Himachal)** for one night. **National Level:** 02 boys U/14 participated in National Hockey championship held at Ranchi Jarkhand from 04.01.2016 to 08.01.2016 organized by SGFI School Games Federation of India. 03 girls participated in 6th Sub Junior women National Hockey Championship held at Nagon Assam from 05.01.2016 to 13.01.2016 organized by Hockey Association of India. U/19 one boy participated in 12th Cadet National Fencing held at Nanded (Maharashtra) from 19.01.2016 to 22.01.2016 organized by Maharashtra Fencing Association. Two boys participated in 17th Sub Junior Fencing Championship held at Nanded (Maharashtra) from 19.01.2016 to 22.01.2016 organized by Maharashtra Fencing Association. 04 girls and 09 boys participated in J&K Judo Championship held at M.A stadium. One boy participated in National fencing championship held at MP from 4.10.16 to 14.10.2016. 03 girls & 01 boy participated in sub junior Judo National championship held at Patna from October 13 to 19, 2016. 03 boys participated in Hockey school National held at Bhopal from November 10 to 28, 2016.

Our students of Junior group and Senior group participated in 24th National Children Science Congress 2016 at state level organized by National Council for Urban and Rural development Society (NCURDS), Jammu and Coin Reading machine prepared by Senior group was selected to represent J&K at 24th NCSC to be held at Pune, Maharashtra from December 27, 2016 to December 31, 2016.

State level: 01 boy and 01 girl participated in 15th J&K karate Do Championship held at Bhartiya Vidhya Mandir School on February 13, 2016. Our school won 01 Gold and 01 Silver medal. 04 girls and 09 boys participated in J&K Judo Championship held at M.A

stadium from February 26, 2016 to February 27, 2016. Our school won 03 Gold, 02 Silver and 02 Bronze. From February 26, 2016 to February 27, 2016. Our school won 03 Gold, 02 Silver and 02 Bronze. U/14 12 boys and U/17 -12 boys participated in Kho-Kho (Boys) held on Government girls HSS Canal Road from April 27 to April 28, 2016 and our school won the match. U/17 Boys participated in Volleyball Championship held at Govt Girls Hr. Sec School Canal Road on April 27 and 28, 2016 and our school was declared Runner up. U/14 06 boys and U/17 06 boys participated in Kho-Kho Championship held from May 07 to 09, 2016 and got 2nd position. U/14 05 girls and U/17 05 girls participated in Kho-Kho Championship held from May 10 to 12, 2016. 02 boys participated in Carom held at M.A stadium on August 19, 2016 organized by Youth Services and Sports Jammu. U/14 02 boys and U/17 02 boys participated in Judo championship held at Degree College Kathua on August 23 and 24, 2016, our students won 02 gold. U/14 02 girls and U/17 01 girl participated in Judo championship held at Degree College Kathua on August 26 and 27, 2016. our students won 02 gold and 01 silver Medal. 01 Boy participated in Basket Ball championship held at Samba on September 01, 2016 and declared winner. U/14 06 boys and U/17 07 boys participated in Hockey championship held at Poonch from August 31, 2016 to September 04, 2016. Both the teams were declared runner up. 03 boys participated in Fencing championship held at Rehari from September 10 to September 14, 2016 and got one Bronze medal. 04 students participated in Kho- Kho Championship held at Rajouri from September 14 to September 18, 2016 and declared runner up. **Other Activities:** Number of students participated in Olympiad Exams and won Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. 15 boys and 09 girls participated in Sahodya Schools Judo championship held at G.D Goenka Public School on May 13 and 14, 2016 our students won 09 gold, 06 silver and 08 Bronze medals. Inter school Olympics 2016 was organized by the local administration in which 250 schools participated and our school got 5th position winning 56 medals. **Social Impact and Community Awareness Program:** Adult literacy program was held on August 08, 2016 at Trilokpur Kherian Jammu in a community hall in which about 20 adults participated. Stationery items were distributed among the adults. Basic concepts of both English and Hindi alphabets were introduced. It was new learning for the adults and they responded well with eager desire to learn. A slide presentation on drug abuse was also shown to students of nearby Government School and adults on the same day. The program further continued on August 16, 2016, August 23, 2016 and on August 30, 2016 in which adults were made aware about the ill effects of drug addiction and how to save from this menace. An adult literacy program was conducted on September 27, 2016 at Kherian Village. Children of nearby Government Middle School were also invited to participate in the said program and the women of the neighborhood were educated about their personal and community hygiene, sanitation, nutritional needs of adolescents. Students of our school presented power point presentation of sanitation and diseases and how to prevent them. The invited students and women participants were opened to questions and their queries were answered by the facilitators over there. Over all program was well organized and successful. **Workshops:** One day workshop was conducted for all the teachers in school by Ms. Kunchal on effective communication, teaching Methodology and strategies and class room management. A part from this several teachers attended no of workshops at local level and also one workshop by CBSE held at JK Public School Jammu. **ANNUAL Day:** Annual Day was celebrated in school premises on October 16, 2016. Mr. Sat Sharma, State President BJP and MLA Jammu west constituency was the chief guest on the occasion. The School is providing much better facilities in comparison to the facilities provided in other schools in the city and has a good impact in the **nearby community** due to good academic results and achievements in sports and other activities. School also organized

several community programs at nearby village for awareness among the students and people. 4th Alumni meet was organized on October 28, 2016.

10 more CC TV cameras were installed in the school campus. Boundary wall for 206 meters has been constructed for the safety of the students. Some more equipments were added in the Gym room for the students.
